

2026 Call for Nominations

Two (2) national position is open for 2026 nominations:

- Two (2) Member-at-Large positions
 - The responsibilities of Consortium Member-at-Large shall be to:
 - 1) Represent the Consortium membership to the Executive Board.
 - 2) Directly support the Committees.

Six (6) regional positions are open for 2026 nominations.

- Three (3) Regional Coordinator positions: Far West, Mid-Atlantic, Midwest
 - Regional Coordinators serve as members of the Executive Board and Executive Committee, maintain liaison between the Executive Board and the Consortium Members in their respective regions, and keep the Executive Board advised on regional matters and issues. They also serve as a point of contact and referral agent for Consortium Members within the region and for the public and private sectors.
- Three (3) Deputy Regional Coordinator positions: Far West, Mid-Atlantic, Midwest
 - Deputy Regional Coordinators assist the Regional Coordinators in their responsibilities and represent their region in the absence or unavailability of the Regional Coordinator.

Far West Region includes: Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Washington

Mid-Atlantic Region includes: Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, Washington, D.C.

Midwest Region includes: Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, Wisconsin

The term of office is October 1, 2026 – September 30, 2028.

Any [Consortium Representative or Consortium Participant](#) may submit nominations to the Nominating Committee. Self-nominations are encouraged.

Eligibility for election as a nationally elected officer shall be limited to laboratory representatives, agency representatives, and Consortium participants (i.e., people that work at our member labs in the broad area of technology transfer).

Nominations must include written approval by the candidate's supervisor (See attached form).

 - c. Past FLC positions, committees, or projects in which you were involved.
