

2025 Call for Committee Chair Nominations

FLC's volunteers stem from the three strategic pillars on which the <u>FLC Strategic Plan</u> is built. Each strategic area — Promote, Educate, and Facilitate — is led by the Committee Chair and represented by a committee focused on a key aspect of the organization's mission. The success of the individual pillars and the FLC as a whole depends on contributions by volunteers who provide a real-world perspective on FLC initiatives.

The FLC's 2025 open Committee Chair positions are:

- Promote Committee Chair: The Promote Committee is all about communicating the
 value of technology transfer as a profession and the FLC as an organization. Its
 mission is to actively promote the availability, benefit, and value of federal laboratory
 assets. View the Promote Committee Charter.
- Educate Committee Chair: The Educate Committee is all about education focused on technology transfer principles and practices. Its mission is to provide full-spectrum education, training, and networking opportunities for federal transfer professionals and key stakeholders, including prospective partners. View the Educate Charter.
- Facilitate Committee Chair: The Facilitate Committee is all about making connections between federal labs and the partners that can help move federal technologies out of the lab and into the market. Its mission is to proactively engage and leverage partnerships that connect relevant private-sector partners with individual federal laboratories to increase measurable outcomes. View the Facilitate Charter.

In accordance with Article 5, Section 2c of the <u>FLC Bylaws</u>, the responsibilities of a Committee Chair shall be to:

- Represent the assigned committee to the Executive Board.
- Chair the assigned committee.

The term of office is October 1, 2025 – September 30, 2027.

Any <u>Consortium Representative or Consortium Participant</u> may submit nominations to the Nominating Committee. Self-nominations are encouraged.

The Committee Chairs are elected in accordance with the <u>FLC Committee Chair Elections</u> <u>Policy here</u>.

All nominations must show written approval by the nominee's supervisor. See attached form.
